This course satisfies the requirements for the Dueling Arts International Level One Skills Test in Single Rapier, Rapier and Dagger, and Unarmed weapons disciplines introduced during the week. An opportunity to test for Dueling Arts Beginning Level recognition skills test is offered at the conclusion of the week of training.
